Your references may also mail their reference directly to Eternity if they choose to do so.

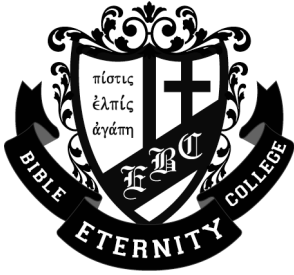

Local Church Mentor/Student Covenant

One Personal Reference
